Subject: Impact evaluation study of the Scheme of reimbursement of funds to Indian Spinal Injuries Centre (ISIC), New Delhi towards the cost of 25 free-bed poor patients- Expression of Interest (Technical and Financial) submitted by National Productivity Council (NPC), New Delhi-regarding.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to National Productivity Council's letter No. ABG/NP/2016 dated 07.04.2016 forwarding the technical and financial proposal on the above subject and subsequent financial negotiation meeting held in this Department on 12.05.2016.

2. Accordingly, it has been decided by this Department to award the contract for conducting impact evaluation study of the Scheme of reimbursement of funds to Indian Spinal Injuries Centre (ISIC), New Delhi towards the cost of 25 free-bed poor patients, on nomination basis in terms of Rule 176 of General Financial Rules, with the following terms and conditions:


- I. The total cost of the project would be Rs.5,15,250/- (Rs.4,50,000/- + Rs.65,250/- towards Service Tax), NPC.
- II. The assignment has to be completed within one and half months from the date of award of contract and its acceptance at your end failing which compensation for delay of work @1.5% per month of delay of work to be computed on per day basis, subject to maximum of ten percent of consultancy fee shall be payable by the Consultant to the Department.
- III. National Productivity Council will not further sub-contract the study to any other agency/individual.
- IV. National Productivity Council will have to furnish a bank guarantee in respect of the said amount in favour of Pay & Accounts Officer, Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities, New Delhi.
- V. 30% of payment shall be released to National Productivity Council as advance payment and balance 70% after submission of the final Report (Ten copies) along with its PDF version and acceptance of the Final Report by the Department.

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3. As already outlined in the Notice inviting Expression of Interest (EOI), the broad Objectives of impact evaluation study are reiterated:

- (i) To assess the outcome and impact of the scheme of reimbursement of funds to ISIC towards the cost of 25 free bed poor patients by intensive interaction with various stakeholders.
- (ii) To suggest measures for maintaining separate accounts and furnishing audited statement of accounts in respect of free bed patients to facilitate release of grants-in-aid by the Ministry as well as from audit point of view.
- (iii) To find out the procedure followed by the Centre for keeping separate account in the case of 10% EWS patients being provided free treatment by ISIC as stipulated while allotting land at concessional rate and as per Court order.
- (iv) To identify whether there is any overlap between free treatment provided to poor patients out of grants-in-aid released by the Ministry and free treatment provided to EWS patients as per Court Order.
- (v) Cross verification of details of 15% poor patients who were provided free hospital care during 2014-15 and 2015-16.
- (vi) To find out the present arrangement by the Centre for prominent display of free bed facility provided by the Centre for poor patients in the public domain of the Centre, for wide publicity among needy patients.
- (vii) To suggest measures for submission of list of free bed poor patients benefitted out of grants-in-aid released by the Ministry separately for verification along with their proposal for reimbursement by the Ministry.
- (viii) To suggest measures for keeping separate category-wise beneficiary list viz. General, SC and ST in respect of GIA received from the Ministry as ISIC do not maintain such list at present.
- (ix) To evaluate whether there is any need to continue the program as well as enhancement of reimbursement amount by the Government for 25 free bed poor patients.

4. If the above terms and conditions are acceptable to National Productivity Council, the same may be communicated to this Department **latest by 30th June, 2016.**
