Subject: Grant in aid to Non-Governmental Organisations (NGOs) under DDRS.

Sir/Madam,

It has been noticed that most of the NGOs have made payment of honorarium to teaching and non-teaching members of the staff in cash.

2. The banking sector in India, in both rural and urban, reflected in the grand success of the 'Jan Dhan Yojna' which has empowered even the poorest and the remotest citizen of the country.
3. All NGOs are, therefore, directed to ensure that all the teaching and non-teaching members/ staff to open their accounts in the nearest nationalized bank under 'Jan Dhan Yojna' and make payment of their honorarium either through cheques or through electronic transfer in the bank.

All NGOs are also advised to send compliance report alongwith details of accounts of the members of the staff in the organization failing which grant from the year 2015-16 will not be disbursed/ reimbursed to the organization. Any deviation in this respect will result in non-release of honorarium and salary amounts on account of teaching and non-teaching staff for which the concerned NGO shall solely be responsible.
