Subject: Release of Grant-in-Aid (non-recurring) to the Government of Odisha for establishment of Early Diagnostic and Intervention Centres in 7 different Districts for hearing impaired infants under the SIPDA Scheme during 2014-15.

Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of President of India to the amount of Rs. 126.00 lakh (Rupees One Crore Twenty Six Lakh only) and release of an amount of only **Rs.99,00,000/- (Rupees Ninety Nine Lakh only)** after adjusting an unspent balance of Rs. 27.00 lakh lying with the Govt. of Odisha from the previous grants released during 2005-06 & 2009-10 for Establishment of Early Diagnostic and Intervention Centres in CDMO Balasore, CDMO Kalahandi, CDMO Bhadarak, CDMO Jajpur, CDMO Dhenkanali, HoD ENT Department VSS Medical College-Sambalpur, HoD ENT Department MKCG Medical Colege, for hearing impaired infants under the Scheme for Implementation of Persons with Disability Act, 1995(SIPDA) during 2014-15.

2. The detailed break-up of **Rs.126,00,000/- (Rupees One Crore Twenty Six Lakh only)** is at **Annexure-I**.

3. It is requested that arrangement may kindly be made to credit this amount in the Bank Account of the Government of Odisha in accordance with the procedure laid down in the Ministry of Finance O.M. 2(45)76-Spl.Cell dated 30.05.76 as modified vide their O.M. of even number dated 16.09.76, under Information to this Section.

4. Name of the Scheme: Scheme arising out of Implementation of PWD Act, 1995 (SIPDA).

5. Purpose for which this grant is sanctioned: Establishment of Early Diagnostic and Intervention Centres in 7 different Districts in Odisha for hearing impaired infants under the SIPDA Scheme during 2014-15.

6. Certified that this sanction has been noted at Sl. No. 12 in Register of Grants (maintained in Form GFR-39).

7. The Grants-in-aid will be regulated in accordance with the provisions contained in the General Financial Rules (GFR), 2005. The Grants-in-aid is also subject to the Chapter 9 of the General Financial Rules, 2005, as amended from time to time and read with the Government of India's decisions incorporated there-under, and any other guidelines which may be issued in this regard, and in particular to the following conditions: -

i) All relevant information and documents /certificates as required under GFR 209 have been received.

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ii) Certified that the pattern of assistance of rules governing such grants-in-aid have received the approval of the Ministry of Finance, as required under Govt. of India Decision No. (1) under DFPR-Rule 20.

iii) The accounts of the Government of Odisha shall be open for audit by C&AG or by any person authorized by him on his behalf in accordance with the provisions laid down in Section 14 of the C&AG (DPC Act 1971) as amended from time to time.

iv) The Accounts of the Government of Odisha shall be open for inspection by the Sanctioning Authority and Audit, both by any other Comptroller & Auditor General of India under the provision of C&AG (DPC Act, 1971) and Internal Audit by the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry or Department whenever it is called upon to do so.

v) Grants-in-aid to the Government of Odisha are subject to the economy instructions issued from time to time by the Ministry of Finance or by any other Competent Authority.

- vi) (a) The Implementing Agency shall submit the final Utilization Certificate for the entire grant along with a project completion report within three months after completion of the work/project as stipulated in the proposal. Unutilized money, if any, is to be refunded to the Ministry. In case the work/project is not completed within the stipulated timeframe and further time is sought to complete the same, the organization concerned has to intimate the Ministry and also explain the reason for the delay. If the project is not completed within the timeframe/extended timeframe, the organization concerned has to refund the grant forthwith.
- (b) The Government of Odisha shall furnish to this Ministry monthly progress report on the project indicating both physical and financial achievements in relation to the approved project.
- (c) The work has to be allotted as per terms and conditions laid down in General Financial Rules (GFR) /Codal Procedure/CVC Guidelines in the matters of contract/financial transactions.
- (d) All other terms and conditions as laid down in GFR would be applicable.
- (e) The Implementing Agency will maintain a website and prominently display details of grant-in-aid received, purpose thereof, events organized and list of beneficiaries, wherever applicable.

vii) The Government of Odisha will confirm that the conditions mentioned in the letter are acceptable to them. The Government of Odisha exempted from executing the bond, to the Government of India.

8. Govt. of Odisha was released grant-in-aid for Rs.16.00 lakh during 2005-06 and Rs.22.50 lakh released during 2009-10 which have remained unspent and out of this grant-in-aid of Rs.11.50 lakh only has been sanctioned/ adjusted during the current financial 2014-15 year to the Govt. of Odisha for strengthening the Office of the State Commissioner for PwDs, thereby leaving an unspent balance of Rs.27.00 lakh, with the State Govt. of Odisha. After adjustment of balance amount of Rs. 27.00 lakh an amount of Rs. 99.00 lakh is being released now, thereby total amount at the disposal of the Govt. of Odisha shall be R. 126.00 lakh for meeting the above expenses. The State Govt. of Odisha will submit Utilization Certificate for total amount.
