

An amount of Rs. 26,52,041/- was released to the Govt. of Himachal Pradesh during 2011-12 for creation for barriers free Environment, for which the Govt. of Himachal Pradesh has not sent the Utilization Certificate. The Screening committee set up by this Ministry has recommended and the same is concurred by IFD of this Ministry for release of grant of Rs.3,15,276/- lakh for strengthening the Office of the State Commissioner for the Persons with Disabilities under the SIPDA Scheme during 2015-16 as a special case. However, the Govt. of Himachal Pradesh is required to furnish the U.C. at the earliest.

If the project is not completed within the timeframe/extended timeframe, the organization concerned has to refund the grant forthwith.


(b) The Government of Uttar Pradesh shall furnish to this Ministry monthly progress report on the project indicating both physical and financial achievements in relation to the approved project.
