Subject: Release of Grant-in-Aid (non-recurring) to the Government of Jammu & Kashmir for barrier free environment for the Persons with Disabilities under the Scheme for Implementation of Persons with Disability Act, 1995(SIPDA Scheme) during 2014-15.

Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of President of India to release of **Rs.6,40,000/- (Rupees Six Lakh and Forty Thousand only)** to the Government of Jammu & Kashmir for construction of ramps and barrier free washroom in the Residential School for the Blind at Roop Nagar, Jammu under the Scheme for Implementation of Persons with Disability Act, 1995(SIPDA) during 2014-15.

2. It is requested that arrangement may kindly be made to credit this amount in the Bank Account of the Government of Jammu & Kashmir in accordance with the procedure laid down in the Ministry of Finance O.M. 2(45)76-Spl.Cell dated 30.05.76 as modified vide their O.M. of even number dated 16.09.76, under information to this Section.
3. Name of the Scheme: Scheme arising out of Implementation of PWD Act, 1995 (SIPDA).
4. Purpose for which this grant is sanctioned: construction of ramps and barrier free washroom in the Residential School for the Blind at Roop Nagar, Jammu
5. Certified that this sanction has been noted at Sl. No. _ in Register of Grants (maintained in Form GFR-39).
6. The Grants-in-aid will be regulated in accordance with the provisions contained in the General Financial Rules (GFR), 2005. The Grants-in-aid is also subject to the Chapter 9 of the General Financial Rules, 2005, as amended from time to time and read with the Government of India's decisions incorporated there-under, and any other guidelines which may be issued in this regard, and in particular to the following conditions: -
 - i) All relevant information and documents /certificates as required under GFR 209 have been received.

ii) Certified that the pattern of assistance of rules governing such grants-in-aid have received the approval of the Ministry of Finance, as required under Govt. of India Decision No. (1) under DFPR-Rule 20.

iii) The accounts of the Government of Jammu & Kashmir shall be open for audit by C&AG or by any person authorized by him on his behalf in accordance with the provisions laid down in Section 14 of the C&AG (DPC Act 1971) as amended from time to time.

iv) The Accounts of the Government of Jammu & Kashmir shall be open for inspection by the Sanctioning Authority and Audit, both by any other Comptroller & Auditor General of India under the provision of C&AG (DPC Act, 1971) and Internal Audit by the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry or Department whenever it is called upon to do so.

v) Grants-in-aid to the Government of Jammu & Kashmir are subject to the economy instructions issued from time to time by the Ministry of Finance or by any other Competent Authority.

- vi) (a) The work should be completed within 6 months from the receipt of the funds.
(b) On completion of the work the Government of Jammu & Kashmir will furnish an audited Utilization Certificate within a period of 6 months of the release of funds along with a report mentioning that the work has been completed.
(c) The Government of Jammu & Kashmir shall furnish to this Ministry monthly progress report on the project indicating both physical and financial achievements in relation to the approved project.
(d) The work has to be allotted as per terms and conditions laid down in General Financial Rules (GFR).
(e) All other terms and conditions as laid down in GFR would be applicable.

vii) The Government of Jammu & Kashmir will confirm that the conditions mentioned in the letter are acceptable to them. The Government of Jammu & Kashmir exempted from executing the bond, to the Government of India.


